**QUICKHEALTH OPENS FIRST SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LONGS DRUGS
LOCATION****- In-Store Doctors Have Saved Californians Over Eight Million Dollars So Far -**

San Mateo, CA February 12, 2008: QuickHealth, Inc. announced today the opening of its latest retail medical store in West Covina, California. This will be the first location to open inside of a Longs Drug Store in Southern California. With the opening of its fifteenth location overall, QuickHealth is providing more Californians with convenient access to a new source of quality medical care: one that has saved over \$8 million for California consumers and taxpayers. QuickHealth provides equal access to healthcare for both the insured and the uninsured at the same affordable price. At QuickHealth you can see a doctor for \$49 seven days a week on a drop-in basis; no appointment is necessary. No insurance is required; services are paid for via cash, check, credit or debt cards. QuickHealth also utilizes low cost prescription drug programs through local retail pharmacies. The new West Covina QuickHealth is located inside the Longs Drug Store located at 727 South Glendora Avenue in West Covina, CA 91790. The telephone number is 626-960-6043.

Since opening its first location in August 2005, QuickHealth has provided Californians with more than 68,000 patient visits where quality health care is delivered by licensed medical doctors in a more convenient and affordable manner than hospital emergency rooms, traditional doctor's offices or urgent care centers. More than 75% of QuickHealth customers are not covered by health insurance, and approximately 40% of those would have sought care in a hospital emergency room if QuickHealth wasn't available. With emergency room visits averaging over \$400, this has resulted in a savings of over \$8 million to California consumers and taxpayers to date.

"With seven million Californians currently lacking health insurance, and millions more concerned about the rapidly rising cost of health care, our newest location in West Covina will offer even more Californians the ability to access quality medical care delivered by a physician at a price they can afford to pay, in a convenient, welcoming location they already frequent, regardless of whether or not they have health insurance" said Dave Mandelkern, president and CEO of QuickHealth.

"We welcome QuickHealth to our West Covina store. This is the fifth Longs Drugs to add a QuickHealth medical clinic within the past year. QuickHealth has a reputation for providing affordable, quality health care that complements Longs' focus on providing our customers quality pharmacy services and

promoting health and wellness in the communities we serve," said Bruce E. Schwallie, executive vice president of business development and managed care for Longs Drug Stores.

QuickHealth operates high quality, affordable medical facilities that care for the whole family. A licensed medical doctor is on-site, as are diagnostic and lab tests. QuickHealth doctors typically treat routine family medical problems such as earaches, fever, and sore throats; provide school, sports, or employment physicals; offer a broad range of immunizations including school, flu, tetanus, or hepatitis shots; and conduct a wide array of diagnostic lab tests including pregnancy, liver function, and tuberculosis screening. Preventive care such as cholesterol checks and diabetes screening is also provided. Minor injuries (such as cuts, sprains, rashes, or insect bites) are also treated. For more serious ailments QuickHealth doctors will refer patients to the appropriate care.

Upon entering a QuickHealth facility, customers see a menu board that clearly spells out the prices of the most commonly requested services. A standard visit with the doctor costs just \$49.00; lab tests and immunizations start at just \$19.00. QuickHealth employs the latest electronic medical record technology in all its facilities.

The West Covina QuickHealth will be open seven days a week; from 9AM to 7PM Monday through Saturday, and from 10AM to 6PM on Sunday. Customers can drop in to QuickHealth at their convenience; no appointment is necessary. Services are delivered in both Spanish and English by a bilingual staff.

QuickHealth doctors accept cash, checks, debit cards, and major credit cards. A receipt form is provided if customers wish to pursue insurance reimbursement on their own.
