Burlingame, CA September 19, 2006: QuickHealth, Inc. announced today a signed lease agreement with Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. that will expand its network to include selected Wal-Mart stores in California. The first QuickHealth facility to be located inside a Wal-Mart store will open in Rohnert Park, California in early October.

"We are pleased to invite QuickHealth into our stores to meet the basic and preventive health needs of local communities and Wal-Mart customers."

QuickHealth operates high quality, affordable medical facilities that care for the whole family. A licensed medical doctor is on-site, as are diagnostic and lab tests. QuickHealth doctors typically treat routine family medical problems such as earaches, fever, sore throat; provide school, sports, or employment physicals; offer a broad range of immunizations including flu, tetanus, or hepatitis shots, and conduct a wide array of diagnostic lab tests including pregnancy, liver function, and cholesterol checks. Minor injuries (such as sprains, rashes, or insect bites) are also treated. For more serious ailments QuickHealth doctors will refer patients to the appropriate care.

Upon entering a QuickHealth facility, customers see a menu board that clearly spells out the prices of the most commonly requested services. A standard visit with the doctor costs just \$39.00; lab tests and immunizations start at just \$19.00. QuickHealth employs the latest electronic medical record technology in all its facilities.

The Rohnert Park QuickHealth will be open seven days a week; from 9AM to 7PM Monday through Saturday, and from 10AM to 6PM on Sunday. Customers can drop in to

QuickHealth at their convenience; no appointment is necessary. Services are delivered in both Spanish and English by a bilingual staff.

QuickHealth doctors accept cash, checks, debit cards, and major credit cards. A receipt form is provided if customers wish to pursue insurance reimbursement on their own.
